As a resident of Butte County, I am writing to strongly support Butte County's position on FERC's Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) on the Oroville Facilities Project. There are three areas where the DEIS fails to address the impact of the Project on Butte County. First, the DEIS fails to fully address costs incurred by Butte County in providing public safety, roads, and other services as a result of the Project; for nearly 50 years, the taxpayers of Butte County have suffered since funding available to provide County services was diverted to the Project. Second, the DEIS fails to address millions of dollars of lost property tax revenues that could have been used to make this County a better place to live. Third, the DEIS fails to address low-cost power that could stimulate much needed economic development in Butte County.
