#### Program Components/Desired Results

- ' Establishing and operating the Breastfeeding Support Center
- ' Creating and distributing Breastfeeding Reference Packet
- ' Trainings for Healthcare Professionals

#### Desired Results

- ' Breastfeeding Center staff will contact 50-75% of their clientele to determine longevity of breastfeeding among clients. Of the women who access the Breastfeeding Center, 35% will report continuing to breastfeed until infant's six-month birthday and 25% will report breastfeeding until their infant's first birthday.
- ' Starting in the second year, mothers who come to the Breastfeeding Center will get a Reference Packet. An effort will be made to ensure the packets will also go home with each new mother in all Butte County hospitals upon discharge.
- ' At least 300 healthcare or service professionals will have attended a basic lactation class over the three-year period.

#### Evaluation Results
