- House establishment (transition from shelter to own home)
- Emergency shelter for women and children. Options available for men. Stay up to 60 days.

Guidelines: If under the influence of drugs or ethanol, may not be admitted.

Hours of Business: 24 hours, check in at 4:30pm, Sunday 1:45-2pm

Services Provided:

Food

- Breakfast 6:45am, Lunch 12pm, Dinner 7pm
- Meals for anyone in need (must be present one hour prior to meals), Dinner (requires chapel services) on Mon-Sat
- On Sundays, Breakfast 7am, Lunch 12pm, Chapel service 3pm, Dinner 4pm
- Bread given away every Tuesday and Thursday from 10am until finished
- Food boxes for families and disabled (Requirements include: current CA identification or driver's license, proof of income, provide Medi-Cal cards or birth certificates for each member of family, provide a current utility bill with name and address, generally may not be under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Available Mon-Wed, 1pm-3pm, 1 box for one family per month, 3 boxes per year)

Shelter

- 1-7 nights stay up to 30 days, varies with each case

Clothing

- Given every day at Men's shelter at 4:30pm
- Given at Women's shelter by appointment
- Must exchange old clothes for new clothes

Guidelines: If alcohol or drugs are used but not acting out, the person may stay.

The next visit, clients must show proof of trying to improve situation such as aluminum can recycling receipt. Food 4 times per year.
