



Butte County Fire and Police Chiefs would like to challenge Butte County teens (16-19 years old) to apply to Butte County's fourth annual **F**ire **A**nd **S**afety **T**raining Camp. All participants will become a team member who will participate in what could be described as a "day-in-the-life-of" police officers, firefighters, paramedics, and rescuers. Campers will be required to spend five nights and six days while participating in Camp. Local firefighters and police officers will challenge, encourage, mentor, support, and guide campers through 6 days of team building, problem solving, and physical activities. Campers will be educated in fire safety, rescue, law enforcement and EMS skills. In addition, campers will complete certification in CPR & Basic First Aid.
