

The 'Bee'line—

- ◆ Each team consists of three members.
- ◆ Teams are given 20 seconds after each question to confer and write down their final answer.
- ◆ One point is given for each correct answer; there are no penalties for wrong answers.
- ◆ There are three rounds: a Qualifying Round, Semi-final Round, and a Final Round. Each new round starts at zero.
- ◆ The Qualifying Round consists of 30 questions.
- ◆ The 10 teams with the highest score will compete in the Semi-final Round of 15 questions.
- ◆ The Final Round for the top 5 teams will have a total of 7 questions.
- ◆ In the event of a tie, a “Sudden Death” tie-breaker will take place.

The heart of Butte County Library Literacy Services is the *Adult Reading Program*. Adults interested in improving their basic reading and writing skills are matched with trained volunteers from the community. Pairs work towards the adult learner's goals which may range from getting a better job to being able to read a bedtime story to his/her child.

Additional activities and support are provided to parents improving their skills with the intention of being able to help their child(ren) through the *Families For Literacy* program. These include special story times and getting children's books into homes to develop home libraries.

Services to school-aged children in the Oroville/Palermo community include one-on-one tutoring at the Library and weekly visits to a local school site serving children struggling with the English language.
