COUNTY DEPARTMENT STATUS UPDATE

To that end, the County of Butte is adjusting its public facing operations of various departments. These changes will allow essential services to continue, while protecting the public. If you need to engage with these Departments, it is recommended you do so, remotely, with the correlating contact information. - **Public Health:** Public facing lobbies are closed, but services at the clinics remain available by appointment only. 530.552.4000 or phinfo@buttecounty.net
- **Sheriff-Coroner:** Public lobby is open as usual. However, in an effort to comply with social distancing, appointments will be required. Such appointments can be made by calling the Records Unit at 530.538.7391, or email BCSOrecords@buttecounty.net.
