for eligible Butte County households affected by the fires

Apply October 25-November 1, 2017

at Butte County Department of Employment and Social Services

Bring proof of identity and local home or work address to in-person interview

If you lived/worked in Butte County during fires that started on October 8, 2017 or after and:

- Lost your home or business,
- Lost income (such as not being able to go to work),
- Lost food (such as experiencing a power outage of four hours or more), or
- Had disaster-related expenses that will not be reimbursed (such as repairs, temporary housing or evacuation expenses)

Income limits are temporarily increased: A household of one with net income under \$1,700 would receive \$192; a household of four with net income under \$2,755 would receive \$640.

In addition, Butte County households may temporarily use SNAP/CalFresh EBT cards to buy hot foods and hot foods ready for consumption through November 15, 2017.

Some customers already getting CalFresh, Medi-Cal or CalWORKs who are affected by fires will automatically receive up to the maximum Disaster CalFresh amount for household size on their EBT cards.

After November 1, residents may continue to apply for regular CalFresh during normal County business hours and on line at c4yourself.com.
