Dear Judge Benson:

Pursuant to Penal Code section 933, subsection (c), the City Council has reviewed the 2012-2013 Grand Jury Final Report. In preparing this response, information and input was obtained from various sources, including the Interim City Administrator. In response to the Grand Jury Final Report filed with the Court on June 11, 2013, the City Council unanimously approved the following response in a public session of its duly noticed meeting held on August 20, 2013.

FINDINGS

F11. The City of Oroville, under contract with DWR, is the Fund Administrator for the Project Supplemental Benefits Fund and will be disbursing grants to the community to stimulate recreation, tourism and economic development.

Response: Agree.

F12. The City Council's adoption of a new Facility and Park Fee Waiver Policy will bring consistency to this process.

Response: Agree.

F13. Although the City of Oroville has a shortfall in its annual operating expenditures as compared to its revenues, City management is transparent about their steps to correct the situation.

Response: Agree.

F14. The City of Oroville balanced its operating budget by using its Contingency Fund.

Response: Agree.

RECOMMENDATIONS

R5. The City of Oroville should develop a sustainable financial plan to replenish their (sic) contingency fund.

The City has established a balanced budget which does not rely upon its contingency fund.
