



2018 Camp Fire Rebuild Incentive Program Application (V6)

One of the following grants may apply to your re-building permit:

NORTH VALLEY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION (NVCF)

\$500,000 – Extended Thru December 31, 2021

Via an amendment of the Grant Agreement between NVCF and Butte County, the grant eligibility requirements have changed as of 9/15/20. The changes are applicable to permits that are issued on 9/15/20 or after, and are not retroactive to previously issued permits.

Grant Eligibility

- Survivors whose home or residential property was completely destroyed or were damaged to the degree that they require permits to rehabilitate the property.
- Grants for a single residence (1 unit per parcel) will be in the amount of 50% of the permit fees, up to \$3500.
- Grants for Master Planned residences will be in the amount of 100% of the permit fees, up to \$3500.
- Grants for garages (up to 700 square feet; square footage above 700 square feet is paid by the permittee) associated with a Manufactured Home will be in the amount of 100% of the permit fees.
- Grants for multiple dwellings (2 or more units per parcel) will be in the amount of 50% of the permit fees, up to \$10,000 total, with a \$2,500 per door maximum).
- Survivors must be the original property owners (on title at the time of the fire) where the home or residential property was destroyed.
- Eligible Survivors may rebuild anywhere within the (Camp Fire) burned communities where direct fire destruction occurred (need not rebuild on their original property).
- Survivors meeting all the criteria listed above who have paid permit fees, are awarded the grant at the time of permit issuance.



Priority is given to survivors who are replacing their primary residence. As such, only up to \$150,000 of the total available grant may be awarded to survivors for more than a single residence (more than 1 unit per parcel) or of multi-family dwellings (2 or more units per parcel). Further, to qualify for this category, the residential unit must have been destroyed or damaged within the County's jurisdiction and will be restored within the County's jurisdictional limits (not inside the Town of Paradise jurisdictional limits).

Grant Eligibility



- Property owners at the time of the Camp Fire, where dwelling was destroyed.
- Non-Veterans – 50% Max, up to \$3500, veterans with qualifying DD214 may receive additional funds.
- Owners only eligible for one grant
- Building permit required to rebuild.
- Rebuilding a comparable (or smaller) replacement residence within an unincorporated community of Butte County substantially affected by the Camp Fire.

CHECK HERE IF YOU ARE A VETERAN AND WANT TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDS WITH VETERAN STATUS . Must also supply a copy of your DD214 form which states the character of service as “Honorable”. Other phrasing which indicates other types of discharge, i.e. “Under Honorable Conditions” are not qualifying for purposes of the grant. Your VA office can assist you in obtaining a copy of a DD214 form.
