## CAMP FIRE HAZARDOUS TREE REMOVAL PROGRAM

### **Our Program -**

- o Our no-cost Tree Removal Program is focused on removing hazardous trees that threaten new-construction or standing homes within the Camp Fire footprint. Under this program, there is a \$4,000 cap per property.

### **To Qualify -**

- o Funds are only available for removing hazardous trees on adjacent properties where the property owner is absent.
- o Hazardous trees threatening new construction or standing structures must not be eligible for the Town or Counties Government Tree Program.
- o Hazardous trees must be threatening new construction or standing structures.

### **Who We Are-**

- o The Butte County Fire Safe Council is a 501(c)(3) non-profit that has been serving Butte County for over 20 years. Traditionally, we have focused on wildfire prevention, safety, and education. Since the 2018 Camp Fire, we have broadened our scope to include fire recovery.
