Guidelines for Visitation

Visits with birth parents or other relatives are usually required as a part of the Family Case Plan and are mandated by the court.

The Social Worker schedules visits and informs the Resource Family in writing of the visitation plan. It is expected that Resource Family and the Social Worker will work together to make visits work for the child and birth family.

Transporting children to two visits per week is the responsibility of the Resource Family. If more frequent visits are expected and the Resource Family needs transportation assistance, they should contact the Social Worker for possible assistance.

The Resource Family must:

- Be on time to drop off and pick up children
- Bring the child's medicine (if needed), formula, diapers, a change of clothing, and toys
- Use the appropriate child safety seat to transport the child
- Never leave the child unattended in the car
- Call reception to assist taking the child to and from your car, if needed
- Be kind and a good example to the birth parents
