### General Information:

Production Agriculture Applications - Notice of Intent: All restricted materials require a 24 hour Notice of Intent unless stated otherwise in a specific permit condition. Pesticide Use Reports are due within 7 days following the application.

Non-Production Ag Applications (MG) – A Notice of Intent is required for the first-time use of each restricted permit material and each time a restricted material is applied to over one (1) acre. In addition, please call the nearest district office at least 24-hours prior to application. Monthly Summary Pesticide Use Reports are due by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the following month.
