I. CALL TO ORDER

- a. Steven Bordin, Chief Probation Officer called the regular meeting of the Community Corrections Partnership (CCP) to order at 9:02 a.m., on May 17, 2017, in the Tahoe Room located at 202 Mira Loma, Oroville, California.
- b. Review of previous committee minutes from March 15, 2017. Chief Bordin asked for a motion to approve the minutes. Ron Reed gave a first and Dorian Kittrell gave a second. The members were all in favor and the motion passes.

II. SUB-GROUP COMMITTEE REPORTS/UPDATES

BUTTE COUNTY PROBATION

--- Melissa Romero, Chief Deputy Probation Officer reported for the Probation Department. Ms. Romero states the department is static in the number of referrals they have been receiving for the PCS/MS populations. Chief Bordin did report that Probation’s caseloads are on the rise; mostly affected by Prop 57 (accelerated credits). Rebecca Henderson, Supervising Probation Officer gave a report regarding Chico PAC for the months of March and April. Chief Bordin gave a brief report on the Drug Court Program reboot.

BUTTE COUNTY SHERIFF’S OFFICE

--- Lieutenant Hovey reported on the jail’s stats, ACS and SWAP.

BUTTE COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

--- Dorian Kittrell, Director, reported on his department’s statistics, providing a handout. Mr. Kittrell stated his department is watching closely what the federal government will do with respect to Medi-Cal and the proposed reduction to that program.

DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE

- Michael Ramsey, District Attorney gave a report on his department's year-end statistics. From 2015 to 2016, there has been an increase in felony requests for complaint approximately, 7%. Mr. Ramsey states there has been an increase by about 8% in misdemeanor requests for complaint. There have been a decrease in the juvenile numbers for felonies; however, there was a "bump-up" in the juvenile misdemeanors. Mr. Ramsey also reported out on the AB109 "rubber-bandits," the FTA's (Failure to Appear).

BUTTE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYMENT AND SOCIAL SERVICES

- Shelby Boston, Director, reported on her department's statistics. She provided a handout to those in attendance and highlighted some of the areas of note. Ms. Boston states there have been a nice increase in employment for their clients.

BUTTE COUNTY OFFICE OF EDUCATION

- Timothy Taylor, Superintendent, reported out on his agency. Commends Debbie Moore; CDCR extends their contract for 5 years thru 2022 for \$11.8 million dollars to serve Red Bluff, Redding, Chico and Oroville. Gives them extra funding for personnel costs and they are also putting \$275k to fund Career Tech Ed to serve their clients. He also commends CCP, DOC...loves the work that is being done up here. Mr. Taylor would like to "retool" the sub-committee regarding Career Tech Ed and academics (Comeback Charter).

SUB-GROUPS/COMMITTEES

UPDATES/DISCUSSION

- There were no subgroups to report at this time.
- Chief Bordin briefly provided an update on the State Legislature. He reports there are many issues. CCP funding will be static, with a slight decrease.
- Item d – Part I. Jim Myers of Gary Bess, Associates gave the quarterly report via PowerPoint on the JAG grant. Dave McKay and Jessenia Guzeldere of YouthBuild Chico also spoke to the group. Mr. McKay announced he would be taking over the Principal's duties at Bidwell Junior High School on July 1.
- Item d – Part II. Kory Honea, Butte County Sheriff via Chief Bordin asks for this item to be removed until a later time.
- Item e. Wayne Barley Chief Deputy Probation Officer, asks the CCP to authorize the purchase (with one-time monies—training dollars) of a slightly used CNC Plasma Table from MJB Welding for ongoing vocational programming between Probation and BCSO. Total with tax will be \$26,812.50. Action/vote needed.

VOTE: Chief Bordin asks the CCP to approve the purchase of the plasma table from MJB Welding. Ramsey gives a 1st, Kittrell 2^{nds}. All in favor with the Court abstaining.
