

What To Do If...

You are exposed to someone with symptoms of or confirmed COVID-19

Are you fully vaccinated?
(Boosted OR not yet booster-eligible)

- It is recommended to be tested 5-7 days from last exposure.
- If you test positive follow isolation recommendations below.
- Wear a mask for a total of 10 days after last contact with a person who has COVID-19.

- Quarantine for 10 days after last contact with a person who has COVID-19 **OR**
- Quarantine for 5 days after last contact with a person who has COVID-19 **IF**
 - you test negative on day 5 or later **AND**
 - symptoms are not present or improving
- Wear a mask for a total of 10 days after last contact with a person who has COVID-19.

Negative

If your test result is:

Positive

- Resume usual activities and self-monitor symptoms for 10 days.
- Wear a mask for a total of 10 days after last exposure.

- Must ISOLATE regardless of vaccination status:**
- 10 day isolation **OR**
 - 5 day isolation if symptoms are not present **AND** if you test negative on day 5 or later.

- Symptomatic: Isolate from first day of symptoms.
- Asymptomatic: Isolate from positive test.
- Wear a mask for a total of 10 days after last exposure.
