**If your test is positive:**

**COVID medications lower your risk of hospitalization and death.**

- See a telehealth provider onsite for FREE within 15 minutes of receiving the test result.
- If the telehealth provider finds you are eligible for medications, you can take medications home with you today.

**See the list below for what puts you at higher risk for hospitalization or death:**
