I. Preliminary Items

A. Call to Order

Elaine called the meeting to order at 9:35 a.m.

B. Roll Call and Determination of Quorum

Stephen Kenny (community event organizer), John Campbell (large market), Dean McKelvey (small market), and John Rawlings (citizen-at-large) were present.

A quorum was NOT established.

II. Action Items

A. Committee Membership

Due to the low turnout for this meeting, those who were present thought it would be best to recruit more committee members and then reconvene in about a month. We need committee representatives from the following categories: Large restaurant, Small/medium restaurant, Mobile Food Facility, School district & News media.

Jennifer will be calling food facility and news media representatives to find potential new committee members. She will let the group know if she needs assistance with that.

B. Temporary Food Facility Application & Handouts

1. We would like to get feedback on our Temporary Food Facility applications and informational handouts. Are they easy for the general public to understand? We will discuss more at the next meeting.

2. Penalty fees for community events were discussed as a way to stop late submittals by event organizers and vendors.



III. Informational Non-Action Items

A. We discussed the issue of CBD Oil being added to food in Butte County. Those present were given the CBD Oil informational handout. At this time, CBD oil is not an approved food additive in retail food facilities in California. Facilities may sell packaged CBD oil derived from hemp to customers. CBD Oil derived from cannabis may only be sold from licensed cannabis dispensaries.

B. We discussed AB 1036 which is a food waste diversion law. John Campbell said that he is looking for an industrial composting facility that will take non-food waste for composting such as paper plates and paper towels. We will have an expert in the food waste diversion law present at the next meeting.

The next meeting will be scheduled for mid-June. The next meeting will include the following on the agenda:

1. Establishment of the committee membership & a new member orientation.
2. Temporary Food Facility overview- discussion & comments.
