



Be Prepared for Emergency Evacuation

A disaster supply kit should include items that are on hand and ready in case you must evacuate your home.

Emergency Evacuation List:

- Full tank of gas in your car
- A three day supply of water for each member of the family
- Wallet/Check book/Cash
- Important Family Documents
- Prescription medications and a list of medications for each person in your group
- Sleeping bags or warm blankets for each person in your group
- Complete change of clothing, for each person in your group
- Children:
 - Sippy cups/bottles
 - Formula and baby food
 - Baby wipes and diapers
 - Recent picture for reunification purposes
- Pets:
 - Food, water, medications
 - Leashes, collars
 - Carriers
 - Photo of pet

It is also very important to have a family emergency plan. In the event of an emergency your family should know what to do in advance and have a plan for how to get back together if separated. Everyone in the family should be aware of the family emergency plan.

Family Emergency Plan Should Include:

- Identify an out-of-town contact. This is a person out of the area and in a safe location that everyone will get in touch with if separated.
- Be sure everyone in your family knows this phone number and has a way to call it (i.e. cell phone, coins, or a prepaid phone card).
- Teach family members how to text. During an emergency text messaging will work when cell phone calling services do not.
