**Road Closure Planned on Glen Drive, above Oro-Quincy Highway**

OROVILLE –

On Monday, May 8, 2017, Butte County Public Works (BCPW) crews and their contractor Franklin Construction are scheduled to begin removing steel plates placed on Glen Drive after the January and February storms. To accomplish this work the road will be closed to through traffic. BCPW and Franklin crews will evaluate the condition of the road surface once the plates are removed to determine if Glen Drive can remain open. This work is scheduled to begin after 8:30 am (after the heaviest morning commute hours) and based on the condition of the road may remain closed until it can be repaired to allow through traffic.

During this road maintenance operation, Glen Drive, between Oro Quincy Highway and the Oroville City Limits at Southview Drive will be closed to all traffic. Traffic will be detoured through Meadowview Drive. Motorists are encouraged to allow extra time for their travel through that area, and to always drive carefully through construction work zones.
