**2017 Butte County Slurry Seal Project  
Paradise Pines Area**

On Monday, September 11<sup>th</sup>, Intermountain Slurry Seal, Inc. is scheduled to begin an asphalt maintenance project under contract with Butte County Public Works to install pavement surfacing treatments in the Paradise Pines Area. This treatment is a preventative maintenance measure to help extend the life of the pavement, and is part of the County's overall pavement maintenance program.

Traffic control on the affected streets will be in effect between the hours of 8:00 a.m. through 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Residents should plan on parking elsewhere if they intend to use their vehicles during this time. Residents/motorists can expect hard road closures for a period of three to four hours while the slurry seal cures, after which time vehicles will be allowed back on the roads. Motorists that need to travel through this area are encouraged to find alternate routes. Traffic control personnel will provide priority access for emergency vehicles as appropriate.

Residents will be notified by door hangers, and by the barricades placed on their streets for the specific date that their road will be slurry sealed. Barricades and door hangers are scheduled to start being placed on September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

We encourage residents to avoid parking in the County right-of-way the night before slurry sealing begins. Any vehicles left parked in the roadway will negatively impact the Contractors ability to complete the project, and those vehicles may have to be towed in order for the work to proceed.


The Contractor is scheduled to complete all work by September 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017.
