Traffic Delays due to Guardrail Replacement on Skyway

Motorists and bicyclists traveling west on Skyway, west of Skyway Crossroad should expect to encounter minor delays. Skyway will be reduced to one lane traveling west. The right lane will be closed as the Contractor (Coral Construction Co.) will be replacing the guardrail that was damaged during the Honey Run Fire. The hours of construction for this project are scheduled to be 8:00 am to 6:00 pm each day.

Motorists should expect minor delays during this construction project. Motorists are urged to use caution and to obey the directions provided by the traffic control personnel. Public Safety emergency traffic will be given priority, and delays should be minimal.

The Butte County Public Works Department has been serving its residents since 1850, providing cost effective roadway maintenance services. The Department maintains approximately 1,300 miles of roadways, over 500 bridges and drainage structures and more than 18,000 road signs.
