Peddler or Solicitor Application Instructions

Are you a Peddler or Solicitor?

Peddlers go uninvited from house to house, place to place, or street to street to sell goods, wares or merchandise you are carrying with you.

Solicitors may go uninvited from house to house to house, place to place, or street to street just as a peddler does. The difference is that you will be taking orders for merchandise for future delivery or for services to be performed in the future.

Application and Licensing Process:

Complete and submit the application, along with a \$5.00 non-refundable application fee, to Butte County Central Collections:

Central Collections will collect the fee, process the application, and refer you to the Butte County Sheriff's Department to obtain an Identification Card.

For Peddlers: The Sheriff's Department will forward the **Identification Card** directly to Central Collections. Central Collections will notify you by phone when your card is ready for pick up and you can complete the licensing process. You will have the choice of purchasing a quarterly or annual license for a fee of \$20.00 per quarter.

For Solicitors: The Sheriff's Department will issue the Identification Card directly to you. There is no need to return to Central Collection. No formal license is issued for solicitors.
