Children's Services

include collections of the best in children's literature, from Brown Bear, Brown Bear to the most recent Newbery award winner. Dedicated staff are always available to help children find what they need. Interactive activities for youngsters and families are also available at your Library, including the annual Summer Library Program and weekly storytimes for infants, toddlers, preschoolers, and school-age children.

Teen activities such as movie nights, writer's workshops, and other get-togethers are held just for teens. Teen collections feature current magazines, young adult books and manga to check out or enjoy in the teen area of your Library.

Book Clubs are sponsored by the Library, and we also have information about other book clubs in the community. Multiple copies of popular titles, discussion guides,

reviews and author biographies are available to start a group or to use with your existing club.

DVD Rentals get the latest newly released blockbuster hits for just \$1 at most library branches. Many older DVD's are free and circulate for a week. Children's and educational DVDs are also available.

Volunteer Opportunities

abound for adults and teens. Shelf books, assist with clerical activities that support library services, help with children's programs, or learn to teach an adult to read. The Library provides these opportunities and more for folks who want to make a valuable contribution, and get involved in their community.

are available free of charge to non-profit and educational groups.

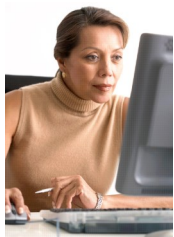

Library Card Basics

Applying for a card

- Minors 17 and under, fill out an application form and have your parent or legal guardian sign it.
- Adults 18+ fill out the application form and show photo ID with proof of current address.

Getting the most from your card

- Please remember to always bring your card when you visit the Library.
- Your first card is free. A replacement card is \$2.50.
- Most materials check out for three weeks. Movies and high demand items check out for one week.
- Renew items online, by phone or at the Library.
