**Why:** Redistricting is a process that occurs following the U.S. Census every ten years. In Butte County, Census data is used to redraw Supervisorial Districts to ensure each district is substantially equal in population. Our communities have shifted significantly due to the Camp Fire and North Complex Fire, making redistricting even more important. Residents are encouraged to submit maps identifying communities of interest and where they feel district boundaries should be located.
