



Formation Description: Formed in accordance with Public Utilities Code Section 21670 and Butte County City Selection Committee Resolution No. 84-2 dated June 28, 1984. The Commission is responsible for protecting public health, safety and welfare by ensuring the orderly expansion of airports and the adoption of land use measures that minimize the public exposure to excessive noise and safety hazards within areas around airports to the extent that such areas are not already devoted to incompatible uses.

Structure / Appointment of Members: The Commission shall consist of seven members to be selected as follows: Two representatives of the cities appointed by the City Selection Committee, two members representing the County appointed by the Board of Supervisors, two members representing the airports within the county appointed by a selection committee comprised of the managers of all the public airports within the county, and one member representing the general public appointed by the other six members of the commission. Each member shall promptly appoint a single proxy to represent him or her in Commission affairs and to vote on all matters when the member is not in attendance. The proxy shall be designated in a signed written instrument which shall be kept on file at the Commission offices, and the proxy shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing member.

Terms: Members are appointed to four year terms after initial term of appointment in accordance with the Commission bylaws. Terms expire the first Monday in May of the year indicated.

- g) The Butte County Superintendent of Schools, who shall serve as an ex-officio member of the Disaster Council without a vote.





Formation Description: The Butte County Fair Association began as a nonprofit corporation on September 24, 1937, and was known at that time as the Paradise Fair and Apple Show Association. On April 6, 1939, the nonprofit corporation changed its name to the Butte County Fair Association. This Committee was formed by Butte County Resolution No. 04-057 as a result of the approval of Senate Bill 621 which established a method for distributing funds from the Indian Gaming Special Distribution Fund to local government agencies impacted by tribal gaming. The Committee shall be composed of five (5) members consisting of the following, or as may be otherwise required by law:

- a. Two (2) representatives from the County, appointed by the County Board of Supervisors;
- b. Three (3) elected representatives from cities located within four (4) miles of a tribal casino in the County, appointed by the County Board of Supervisors based upon nominations from the City Council(s). In the event that there are no cities within four (4) miles of a tribal casino in the County, other local representatives may be selected upon mutual agreement by the County Board of Supervisors and a majority of the tribes in the County paying into the Indian Gaming Fund. However, if only one city is within four (4) miles of a tribal casino and that same casino is located entirely within the unincorporated area of that particular county, only one elected representative from that city shall be included on the Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee;
- c. Two (2) representatives selected upon the recommendation of a majority of the tribes paying into the Indian Gaming Special Distribution Fund in the County. If there are no tribes in the County paying into the Indian Gaming Special Distribution Fund, the two representatives may be selected upon the recommendation of the tribes operating casinos in the County.

Terms:

Terms of office of the members shall be four years expiring on June 30 of the appropriate years and subsequent new terms shall begin July 1 of that year. The first term of office shall be deemed to commence on July 1, 2004 only for purposes of subsequent appointment of members. (For all other purposes,

On August 24, 1999, the Articles of Incorporation were amended increasing the number of directors from 13 to 19.


