

AT RISK ADULT DIRECTORY

Law Enforcement often needs help from the community when adults with dementia, Alzheimer's disease, or other conditions wander from their homes.

The At Risk Adult Directory is designed to assist law enforcement to locate, identify, and safely return your loved one in case he or she wanders.

By providing the Sheriff's Office with personal information and a photograph of an at-risk adult before they wander, law enforcement response time will be decreased and deputies may have a better chance of locating your loved one.

If you are a caretaker or a loved one of an adult who suffers from dementia, Alzheimer's disease, or another condition which causes him or her to wander from home, the Butte County Sheriff's Team of Active Retired Seniors (STARS) can be of assistance.

The STARS volunteer personnel will come to your residence and take a photograph and description of your loved one.

They will also gather information which will be necessary for law enforcement to have if the individual ever wanders. This information includes the person's name, physical description, address, and characteristics.

This information will then be entered



The directory will assist law enforcement to identify and return the citizen.

into a confidential log book which is stored in the Butte County Sheriff's Dispatch Center.

AT RISK ADULT DIRECTORY

The log book, entitled the "At Risk Adult Directory," is strictly confidential but will assist law enforcement personnel to identify and return the citizen to their home if he or she wanders and becomes disoriented.

This book will contain the personal information of your loved one as well as his or her picture. Deputies and Search and Rescue personnel will be able to view this information as soon as you report your loved one missing.

In some instances, the photograph and general information of the missing adult will be released to the media (with your permission) if necessary.

**THE STARS
ORGANIZATION**

The Sheriff's Team of Active Retired Seniors is comprised of volunteers age 50 years or older. Each volunteer attends a 40 hour training academy, passes an extensive background investigation, and completes a Field Training program.

STARS involved with the At Risk Adult Directory have also undergone training in conjunction with the Butte County Sheriff's Office and the Northern California Alzheimer's Association.



The STARS volunteers are trained and have passed an extensive background investigation.
