COLLECTED BY STAFF/CSUC NURSING, NUTRITION,
AND HEALTH EDUCATION STUDENTS:

- County-wide statistics on the number and percentage of BC mothers who breastfeed their babies during the early post-partum period, at six months, and at the end of one year

REFERENCE PACKETS

By the 2nd year of the project, each mother of a new baby will receive a packet in her hospital discharge packet, and each time a new mother is referred to the Breastfeeding Center, she will receive a packet.



COLLECTED BY BCBC STAFF:

- A count of the number of packets distributed to post-partum mothers referred to the Center as well as the number of packets distributed in hospital discharge packets for new mothers will be recorded.

TRAININGS FOR HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS

One training will be held each year. The training will likely be a one- to two-hour session.

Once the center is established, should the need arise from mothers for the center breastfeeding support groups, birthing education classes, lactation classes, nutrition classes, or baby safety classes will be provided



COLLECTED BY TRAINING INSTRUCTORS:

- Class sign-in sheets and knowledge test results

COLLECTED BY PROJECT STAFF:

- If needed, data from mothers who participate in any activities listed above. Instruments will include knowledge questions.
