Parents can be involved in one or all of the following program components:

IN HOME PARENTING CLASSES

The average service length is six weeks at one visit per week. Five, six-week In-Home Parenting Sessions will be conducted each year.

COLLECTED BY SOCIAL WORKERS:

- Pre/post assessments at beginning and end of six-week period.
- Weekly log of participation by Social Worker

COLLECTED BY TCPCC PROGRAM STAFF:

- TAPP social worker questionnaire completed near end of each program year.

COLLECTED BY TCPCC PROGRAM STAFF & TAPP SOCIAL WORKERS:

- Six-month client follow-up survey administered near end of year to that year's clients who ended services six months or more prior.

YOUNG FATHERS' SUPPORT GROUP

Over 3-year period, total of four one to two-hour sessions weekly for 9 weeks

COLLECTED BY GROUP FACILITATORS:

- Sign-in sheets collected weekly.
- Pre & post assessments collected at the beginning and end of each nine-week session

COLLECTED BY TCPCC PROGRAM STAFF:

- YPSS facilitators' qualitative questionnaire completed near end of each program year.
- TAPP social worker questionnaire completed near end of each program year.

COLLECTED BY TCPCC PROGRAM STAFF & TAPP SOCIAL WORKERS:

- Six-month client follow-up survey administered near end of year to that year's clients who ended services six months or more prior.

MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING

1 day/week in Chico (Fairview Continuation School) and 1 day/week in Oroville (Prospect Continuation School). Sessions may also be conducted at the SERV Center or NVCSS counseling offices. The average length of service will be 16 sessions, to be adjusted if client needs dictate. The

COLLECTED BY THERAPISTS:

- Service logs completed weekly.
- Discharge Summary at end of each client's counseling period.
- Pre and post client assessment at beginning and end of counseling period.

COLLECTED BY NVCSS PROGRAM STAFF

- Teacher client progress survey completed near end of each program year.

COLLECTED BY TCPCC PROGRAM STAFF:

- TAPP social worker questionnaire completed near end of each program year.

COLLECTED BY TCPCC PROGRAM STAFF & TAPP SOCIAL WORKERS:

- Six-month client follow-up survey administered near end of year to that year's clients who ended services six months or more prior.
