

## **POLICY 102**

### **Chief Executive Officer**

#### **102.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE**

The California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) has mandated that all sworn peace officers employed within the State of California shall receive certification by POST within prescribed time periods.

#### **102.11 CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REQUIREMENTS**

Consistent with the job specifications submitted to Butte County Human Resources are currently as follows:

Bachelor's degree earned for course work completed through a college or university accredited by an accrediting body recognized by the U.S. Department of Education or from an institution authorized to award degrees pursuant to Section 94900 of the California Education Code AND six (6) years experience in law enforcement, including three (3) years of law enforcement supervisory experience.

OR

Associate degree or (60) semester / (90) quarter units earned for course work completed through a college or university accredited by an accrediting body recognized by the U.S. Department of Education or from an institution authorized to award degrees pursuant to Section 94900 of the California Education Code AND eight (8) years experience in law enforcement, including four (4) years of law enforcement supervisory experience.

California Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Management certificate required

At any time the requirements for this position change, the controlling document will be that which is on file with Butte County Human resources.

#### **102.2 CHIEF INVESTIGATOR**

The Chief Investigator is the chief executive officer of the District Attorney's Bureau of Investigation. The Chief Investigator is supervised by the District Attorney, who is the appointing authority.
