# District Attorney Investigator - Requirements of Appointment

### 103.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose and scope of this policy is to ensure that individuals appointed to the position of District Attorney Investigator meet the requirements mandated by the California Commission on Peace Officers Standards and Training (POST).

### 103.11 REQUIRED POST TRAINING

1) Any individual appointed to the position of District Attorney Investigator after January 1, 1998, shall have completed the course of training prescribed by POST and obtain the Basic Certificate within one year of appointment.

2) Within one year of appointment to the position of District Attorney Investigator, the investigator shall attend the POST *investigation and Trial Preparation Course for District Attorney Investigators and Inspectors*.

3) Individuals who previously obtained the Basic Certificate, but who have been unemployed from California law enforcement for three consecutive years or longer, shall attend the POST *Re-qualification Course* prior to appointment to the position of District Attorney Investigator.

### 103.12 POST SELECTION STANDARDS

Prior to appointing an individual to the position of District Attorney Investigator, the Butte County District Attorney's Bureau of Investigation shall adhere to the POST Selections Standards for Peace Officers. In accordance with the POST Selection Standards:

1) A background investigation shall be completed to determine the applicant's suitability to be a peace officer.

2) A medical examination shall be completed to determine the applicant's suitability to be a peace officer.

3) A psychological screening shall be completed to determine the applicant's suitability to be a peace officer.
