Required Duty Equipment

701.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

It is the policy of the Butte County District Attorney's Bureau of Investigation that on duty Investigators have, readily accessible, the equipment they need to perform law enforcement functions.

701.11 REQUIRED LAW ENFORCEMENT EQUIPMENT AND POLICE IDENTIFIERS

While on duty, Investigators are required to be in possession of the following items:

- (a) Duty weapon and at least one spare magazine
- (b) Handcuffs
- (c) Badge and Department issued identification card
- (d) Cellular telephone

Investigators operating in an undercover capacity are excused from these requirements.

While on duty, Investigators are required to have reasonably access the following items:

- (a) Hand held radio with an operational battery
- (b) Ballistic vest
- (c) Department issued shotgun, and if approved, Department issued or authorized rifle or submachine gun

"Reasonable access" means immediate access to, without significant delay beyond normal storage or other security/ safety measures.
