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**OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS**

- 1- Fax copy of current food safety certificate to this Dept. Include name of facility on fax.
- 33- Resecure loose formica on prep counter in "outside" upstairs kitchen.
- 34- Obtain test papers for checking sanitizer level in rinse cycle of dishwasher—check sanitizer level daily. Sanitizer level OK at time of inspection.
- 35- Top, inside of microwave oven is loose. Replace/ repair so as to be in good repair. If microwave oven is replaced replacement shall be an NSF approved commercial unit.
- 36- Ice scoops stored directly on top of ice machine—scoops placed on washable tray during inspection.
- 38- No cover observed on overhead light in food storeroom.
- 41- Finish repairing/ replacing drain line at one- compartment sink in downstairs kitchen.
- 44- a) Employee's personal items stored on top of microwave oven in downstairs kitchen. Provide a separate, designated area for storage of employee's personal items.
  - b) Check containers of food in food storeroom—remove unused/ old containers so as to facilitate cleaning.
- 45- a) Patch/ repair worn areas of walls in upstairs kitchen so as to facilitate cleaning.
  - b) Clean floor, under ice machine, of sticky residues, etc.
  - c) Resecure loose floor coving along cabinets in upstairs, "outside" kitchen.
  - d) Continue to repair damaged area of ceiling in downstairs kitchen. Finish repairing roof as needed.
- 52- Remove absorbent cloth towel draped over beverage boxes in upstairs kitchen. OK to use a non-absorbent, easily cleanable cover if needed over beverage boxes.
