OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: 7- Observed assorted deli meats at 43°F-48°F in sandwich prep refrigerator. Adjust/repair unit or keep lids down between orders to maintain at 41°F or below.

29- Observed a few unlabeled chemical spray containers in facility. Label as to contents.

35- Observed broken door handle on proofer. Replace to facilitate cleaning.

36- Observed CO2 tank to be unsecured. Secure with available chain.

39- No probe thermometer for checking hot holding temperatures. Provide.

41- Observed hot water valve on front hand sink faucet to be nonoperational. Repair.

44- Observed wet mop stored with head down in mop sink. Store mop so as to dry completely between uses.

45- Clean floor sinks under prep sink and utensil sink to remove residues.

Reinspection fees will be charged for all subsequent reinspections unless an acceptable corrective time schedule has been submitted and approved by this Department. If, for any reasons beyond your control, you cannot correct the indicted violations by the next scheduled time, call this office prior to the inspection day.
