OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

Main Bar

- 6) Provide a paper towel dispenser for utensil sink on right side of bar (used as a hand sink).
- 34) No quaternary ammonia test strips available for checking sanitizer levels at utensil sink – provide. (Note: Chlorine test strips available). Observed dirty ash trays stored on the right-side utensil sink- remove.
- 35) Replace the beverage tubing/cold plate beverage cooling device in the ice storage bin with a cold plate that does not come into contact with the ice within 6 months. Observed waste lines for beverage gun holders passing through customer ice. Move waste lines so that they do not pass through customer ice bins. Clean the beverage gun holders to remove algal residues. Clean inside the ice machine to remove brown residues.
- 36) Chain/secure all CO2 tanks to a rigid structure.

Kitchen

- 33) Paint/seal all bare wood utensil storage drawers and cabinet shelves in the dishwasher room.

Auxiliary Bar

- 6) Provide a paper towel dispenser and paper towels at the utensil sink (also used as hand sink).
- 35) Replace the beverage tubing/cold plate beverage cooling device in the ice storage bin with a cold plate that does not come into contact with the ice within 6 months. Observed waste line for beverage gun holder passing through customer ice. Move waste line so that it does not pass through customer ice bin. Clean beverage gun holder to remove algal residues.
