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OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

- 22-** Reported that mop water is dumped into storm drain behind building. Mop water shall be properly disposed into an approved sewage system (i.e. toilet in restroom).
 - 33-** Clean cabinet bottom under ice cream storage freezer to remove some misc. debris/dust. Seal bare/worn wood trim at ice cream freezer to facilitate cleaning. Replace worn seal at (cold storage) yogurt toppings refrigerator between topping pan storage and wooden counter to facilitate cleaning.
 - 35-** Replace cracked/damaged blender pitchers. Observed faceplate of blender to be damaged. Clean rubber mat under ice shaver to remove some misc. debris/dust. Observed ice shaver machine draining into covered plastic container stored on prep table shelf (below machine). Note: If, during routine health inspections, it is determined that the plastic container for ice shaver is not/cannot be maintained in clean manner then ice shaver shall be relocated to properly drain into approved indirect sewage connection. (Ice shaver container/area OK when checked during inspection).
 - 45-** Observed some misc. residues/debris on floor along cove base tiles and in hard-to-reach areas. Observed some gaps in ceiling panels (at wall/ceiling junctions). Observed missing (top-set) floor base behind utensil sink.
- Note: Walls behind some food dispensing/prepping and open food storage areas (i.e. behind yogurt machines, ice machine, storage refrigerators/freezers) are rough/textured.
- Note: Verified that leftover yogurt at end of days' operations is poured from machines and stored in buckets overnight inside walk-in, then disposed of at utensil sink. Reported that yogurt machines are sanitized daily (in morning).
