- 34) No test strips available for checking sanitizer levels at the dishwasher – provide.
- 35) Clean inside the ice machine to remove black residues. Replace both beverage tubing and non-integral cold plate beverage cooling devices in the ice storage bins with cold plates that do not come into contact with the ice used for customer drinks within 6 months to a year.
- 36) Chain/secure the CO2 tank in the walk-in cooler to a rigid structure.
- 45) Repair the sheet vinyl floor coving at back wall of walk-in cooler where it is coming away from the wall. Repair the damaged flooring at door between front and back prep areas.
