 Obtain test strips to check dishwasher daily. Reported utensils will be manually sanitized at utensil sink (bleach – water 30 sec).
 29- Label spray bottles. 35- Provide means of separating customer beverage ice from cold plate in bottom of cocktail unit (i.e. separate insulated ice bin, drainable container). 36- Observed ice scoop stored atop box of plastic utensils. 45- Clean floor at bar to remove misc. debris.
 Replace missing floor at bar.

Reinspection fees will be charged for all subsequent reinspections unless an acceptable corrective time schedule has been submitted and approved by this Department. If, for any reasons beyond your control, you cannot correct the indicted violations by the next scheduled time, call this office prior to the inspection day.
