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OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

- 6- Observed paper towels at kitchen hand sink to be stacked on pass through window ledge. Place paper towels in available sanitary dispenser.
- 14- Water in wash basin of utensil sink 92°F during inspection. Maintain wash water at 110°F or above whenever wash basin is filled.
- 34- Observed pan catching water and leak at drain pipe under utensil sink. Repair.
- 36- Observed styrofoam cups used as scoops in bulk food containers. Provided handled scoops to prevent physical contamination of foods. Observed spoons stored with handles in both directions in customer self service container. Store spoons with handles in one direction so as not to contaminate eating surfaces with customer hands.
- 38- No shatter proof light cover on light in walk-in refrigerator or light fixture over prep refrigerator. Provide.
- 39- Observed thermometer attached to fan box in walk-in refrigerator. Relocate thermometer or provide additional thermometer at warmest location in walk-in refrigerator (i.e.: upper shelf by door).
- 41- Observed prep sink to have been relocated and directly plumbed since last inspection. Provide indirect plumbing/drainage.
- 44- Observed CO2 tanks to be unsecured. Secure to rigid structure.
