OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: 5- Observed food handler wash hands at hand sink then dry hands by wiping on towel hanging from apron strings. Dry hands on single use paper towels.

7- Observed miso soup, which had reportedly just been made, at 99°F in crock pot. Use probe thermometer to ensure soup is 135°F before hot holding.

14- Reported slicer is cleaned by wiping with towel. Proper cleaning procedure for slicers is wash with hot, soapy water, rinse and sanitize with approved sanitizer.

30- Observed foods stored in open tins cans in walk-in refrigerator. Store in approved, easily cleanable containers once opened. Observed uncooked scallops stored on box of uncooked celery. Discontinue storage of meats over produce so as to prevent contamination.

35- Observed domestic crock pot in use in wait station. Replace with NSF approved commercial unit.

44- Observed wet mop stored in mop bucket. Store mop so as to dry completely between uses.

Reinspection fees will be charged for all subsequent reinspections unless an acceptable corrective time schedule has been submitted and approved by this Department. If, for any reasons beyond your control, you cannot correct the indicted violations by the next scheduled time, call this office prior to the inspection day.
