OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: Note: No food preparation (ie: making ice) occurring at facility.

6- Refill empty soap and paper towel dispensers at hand sink; also empty toilet paper dispenser in restroom.

27- Temperatures of potentially hazardous foods reportedly not being checked at time of delivery. Use probe thermometer (available) to check temperatures.

35- Defrost all display freezers and remove cardboard shelf liners in freezers. Replace damaged, taped handle on ice freezer.

38, 43- Repair non-functioning vent fan in restroom. Replace missing toilet tank lid and toilet seat in restroom.

44- a) All exterior doors left open at time of inspection. Keep exterior doors closed or provide air curtains or screen doors.

b) Clean up/ organize misc. items stored in various back rooms so as to eliminate clutter and facilitate cleaning.

c) Containers of frozen meat (reportedly personal food) observed in ice display freezer. Packages of meat will reportedly be removed from freezer today.

45- Finish patching/ repairing ceiling in display area.
