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OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

- 7, 39-** Observed chicken tenders 121-125°F hot-holding in hot case for short time period. (Note: all other hot-holding foods in hot case ok, 135+°F). –Observed 3 roasted chickens 51-52°F (cooked/packaged at deli), 5 packages 8-piece chicken pieces (cooked/packaged at deli) and 1 10-piece packaged chicken wings (cooked/precooled) in cold-holding deli case. Chicken voluntarily discarded to trash during inspection, see VC&D. Ensure all foods cooked/packaged at deli are properly cooled to at least 41°F (internally) prior to displaying in retail display refrigerator.
- 31-** Observed some mildew inside ice chute of Pepsi machine.
- 36-** Observed double-handled knife covered with taped cardboard sheath.
- 45-** Observed missing top-set cove base at deli case.
