OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS:

- 14, 34- No sanitizer detected in 'sanitize' basin of utensil sink (when checked using inspector's test strips) and no test strips readily available at facility. Sanitizer (bleach) added to basin during inspection and OK. Obtain chlorine test strips so as to be available and ensure at least 100ppm is available at utensil sink.
- 35- Clean plastic panel inside ice bin to remove pinkish-colored residues.
- 41- Provide drain line to ice bin, that is currently dripping water onto floor, and route line to drain to floor sink
- 44- Serving window left open between customers and back door open upon arrival and throughout inspection.
- 45- Observed concrete floor to be hard-to-maintain having worn paint/seal, areas of exposed aggregate and puddles of water. Repair hole in wall below (west-facing) serving window.

Note: Facility has written and posted operational procedures for time-only as health control for coffee syrups. Reported syrups are changed out 3x per day.

Reinspection fees will be charged for all subsequent reinspections unless an acceptable corrective time schedule has been submitted and approved by this Department. If, for any reasons beyond your control, you cannot correct the indicted violations by the next scheduled time, call this office prior to the inspection day.
