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OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

30- Some cardboard boxes of bags of food displayed on floor.

32, 15- No labels observed on packages of "Water Melon" candy. According to owner, candy is purchased at a facility in Sacramento's China Town (owner did not know name of facility). Verify "Water Melon" candy is from an approved source.

35- a) Replace domestic storage refrigerator with a commercial storage refrigerator. Clean storage refrigerator of food residues, ice build-up, etc.

b) Display freezer not operating properly. New motor for freezer is reportedly being ordered. Frozen food is currently being stored in storage freezer.

38- Repair broken ventilation fan in left restroom.

39- No thermometer observed in storage freezer or in storage refrigerator.

45- Repair worn, absorbent area of wall behind handsink in left restroom.
