- 13) Observed a torn bag of flour on retail shelf. Flour was discarded during inspection.
- 30) Observed some open bulk bags of oats and wheat bran that were not clamped closed in back bulk foods storage area.
- 32) No label observed on bulk couscous bin in natural foods section- provide.
- 39) Replace/repair the inoperable thermometer inside display freezer over meatballs and hamburger patties.
- 44) Observed 3 wet mops stored in mop buckets in back storage area. Hang mops to air dry after use.

Meat Dept.

- 34) Replace the 2-compartment utensil sink with a 3-compartment sink within the next 6 months to a year.
