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OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

- 14, 31-** Remove and clean soda machine nozzles to remove some mold and encrusted residues. Clean inside cappuccino machine, and nozzles, to remove beverage/coffee residues.
- 27-** Observed cartons of raw shell eggs stored on shelf above milk in retail display refrigerator.
- 30-** Observed boxes of coffee creamers and bulk condiment containers (mustard, ketchup) stored directly on floor of walk-in.
- 33-** Clean inside cabinets storing soda syrup boxes to remove dust and some sticky residues. Seal bare wood shelves in cabinets (storing cups, coffee powders/grounds, etc) at beverage area to facilitate cleaning.
- 38-** No shatterproof light bulbs/covers for overhead lighting inside walk-in or at utensil sink.
- 44-** Remove unused/inoperable food equipment from facility.
