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OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

- 5-** Observed food handler enter kitchen area and resume food/utensil handling without properly washing hands at hand sink. Discussed hand washing with operator during inspection. Note: Food handler's use of hand sanitizer does not replace proper hand washing.
- 30-** Observed soiled wiping rag and dustpan stored atop (unpeeled) onions stored in box on prep table shelf.
- 35-** Remove protective shipping adhesive from sides of hot-holding cabinets to facilitate cleaning.
- 36-** Observed racks atop prep refrigerators to be rusted in areas and soiled with some dried food residues.
- 44-** Observed janitorial sink to be obstructed with 2 bags filled with greenish-viscous liquid and other misc. items.
- 45-** Observed vinyl-comp floor tiles to be cracked/damaged at cove along walls throughout facility.
