OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

- 14) Observed used tray/tong sets for customer self service of pastries/cookies on front counter. Person in charge reported that trays/tongs are washed at night. Wash, rinse, sanitize and air dry trays after each use or provide bags or boxes for customer use. Reported that utensils are not sanitized after being washed and rinsed. Wash, rinse and sanitize (using a solution of about 1 ounce of bleach for every 4 gallons of water) and then air dry utensils. Note: No utensil washing observed during inspection.
- 34) Replace the 2-compartment utensil sink with a 3-compartment sink within the next 6 months, or provide approved detergent/sanitizer to be used in 2-compartment sink. No test strips available for checking sanitizer (bleach) levels at the utensil sink – provide.
- 35) Clean underside of mixers to remove food residues.
- 36) Clean all soiled decorating supplies/utensils in plastic storage containers to remove food debris. Clean inside and outside of utensil storage containers to remove food debris.
