OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS:

- 6- No paper towels in dispenser of restroom #2.
- 13- Observed damaged/moldy packages of hot dogs and cheese. Foods voluntarily discarded during inspection, see VC&D.
- 14- Remove and clean nozzles of soda machine to remove mold.
- 33- Clean countertop of beverage counter to remove dust and misc. debris/residues.
- 35- Clean outsides of coffee airpots to remove encrusted residues. Ensure airpots are properly cleaned and sanitized daily.
- 35, 45- Clean milk display racks and floor (under racks) to remove dried milk residues.
- 41- Clean floor sinks throughout facility, especially for refrigeration condensate, to remove accumulated mold.
- 45- Clean floors under shelving in back room to remove dust/trash. Clean area around soda box rack (walls, back of machine) to remove sticky residues.

Reinspection fees will be charged for all subsequent reinspections unless an acceptable corrective time schedule has been submitted and approved by this Department. If, for any reasons beyond your control, you cannot correct the indicted violations by the next scheduled time, call this office prior to the inspection day.
