**OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS**

- 4) Observed a couple of uncovered employee drink cups stored near food prep tables.
- 35) Clean the shelves where fryer supplies are stored to remove sticky/greasy residues. Clean the inside top of the ice machine to remove algal residues.
- 36) Wash, rinse and sanitize cutting gloves (that are reportedly used with disposable gloves over them) rather than just sanitizing. Observed clean dishes stored on a tray with greasy/wet paper lining it. Remove the paper and clean tray; do not store utensils on absorbent material.
- 41) Repair the leaks from the faucet and plumbing of the back hand sink, and the leak from the faucet of pot sink near the dishwasher.
- 45) Replace the cracked tile flooring in the walk-in cooler. Clean the ceiling in the corner near the dishwasher to remove brown residues.

**Bar**

- 7) Observed 3 cartons of smoothie mix 49°F and a can of whipped cream stored too high above ice. Store lower in ice or in refrigerator.
- 35) Clean the beverage gun holder to remove algal residues.
- 45) Clean floors in hard to reach areas to remove accumulated residues.
