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OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

- 1- No food safety certificate. Provide documentation within sixty days that at least one person currently working at this facility has passed an approved food safety certification examination. Fax or mail to this Department. Please include name of facility on certificate.
- 6, 41- Observed hand sink to be blocked by cups, napkins and binder and drain pipe at hand sink to be leaking. Repair leak and remove items from hand sink. Keep hand sink fully accessible for employee hand washing.
- 6- No hand soap at hand sink. Provide soap in sanitary dispenser.
- 29- Observed spray container of Ortho Hornet and Wasp Killer under mop sink. Remove domestic insecticide from facility.
- 32- No ingredient lists available for plastic wrapped pastries and scones obtained from Cal Java. Provide.
- 35- Observed standing water/leak under ice machine and standing water/leak at hose connection of insulated ice bin by hand sink. Repair.
- 45- Clean walls where needed to remove beverage residues and floor where needed to remove debris/residues.
