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**OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS**

- 1) No food safety certificate available during inspection. A food safety certificate is required if tamales will continue to be served from this facility.
- 6) Refill the empty paper towel dispenser at the hand sink.
- 9,15) Observed 36 pork and chicken tamales 112-117°F (source unknown) wrapped in foil and stored in paper bags cooling incorrectly in the display refrigerator. Tamales were voluntarily discarded to the dumpster by employee during inspection, see VC&D form dated same.
- 15,50) Observed 21 pork and chicken tamales and an unlabeled bottle of tamale sauce stored in the display refrigerator. Unable to verify that tamales and sauce came from an approved source during inspection. Sauce and tamales were impounded by inspector during inspection, see Impound form dated same. Do not sell, use or remove tamales and sauce until released by this Department.
- 35) Clean the bottom of the keg refrigerator to remove standing water and brown residues.
- 39) No thermometer inside the display refrigerator (storing tamales)- provide.
